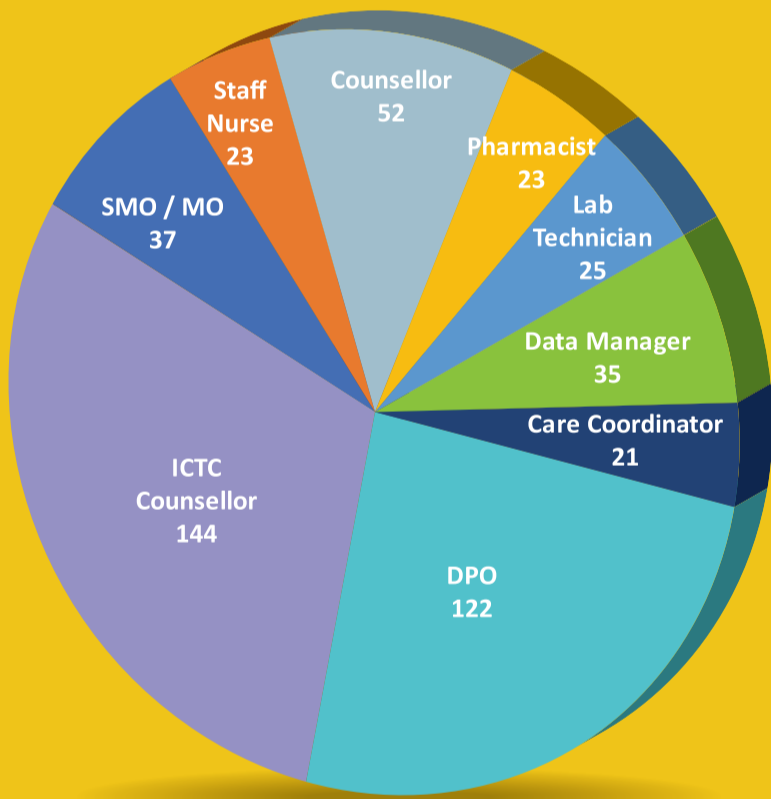

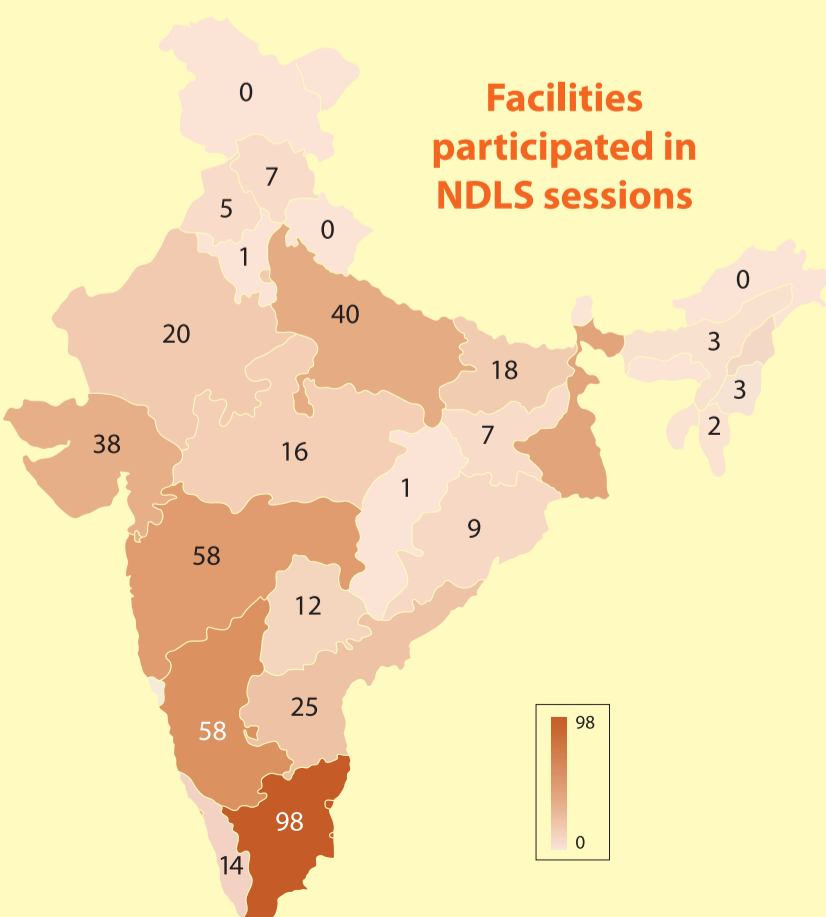
**Cadre wise participation**
