






INTEGRATED SERVICE DELIVERY FOR MANAGEMENT OF HIV-NCD COMORBIDITIES AMONG PLHIV

Non-Communicable Diseases (NCD) are chronic diseases which can be prevented by lifestyle modification

People Living with HIV (PLHIV) are at increased risk of NCD especially Hypertension, Cervical Cancer, Diabetes, and Mental Health conditions

- Feeling very thirsty
- Loss of weight
- Blurred vision
- Feeling very tired
- Numbness or tingling in hands

Common



CHEST PAIN

VOMITING

Common Symptoms Malaise/ Uneasiness

- Nausea and Vomiting
- Light headedness

Warning/Danger Symptoms

Difficulty in breathing

HYPERTENSION

- Severe headache
- Anxiety
- Blurred vision or other vision changes
- Sudden, severe pain in abdomen, chest, or back

MENTAL HEALTH CONDITIONS

- Feeling worried, anxious or stressed
- Difficulty in handling day to day activities
- Changes in sleeping and eating habits
- **Changes in emotions**
- Withdrawal from family and friends

CERVICAL CANCER

- Vaginal bleeding between periods, after sex, or after menopause
- Vaginal discharge that is watery, has a strong odour, or contains blood
 - Heavier or longer periods
- Pain in the pelvis, lower back, or legs

Remember

All PLHIV should get screened as early as possible and at regular intervals thereafter for early diagnosis and proper management.

NCD screening and treatment is available FREE OF COST at ART centers, NCD clinics and other government health facilities.

Screening, Referrals and Linkages

Coordinated efforts by ART centers and NCD clinics for complicated cases management, supplies, data sharing and case-based monitoring



Referrals for further management & expert consultation

PLHIV with

Uncontrolled DM / complications, Elevated BP readings (emergency/urgency), Mental health conditions, Cervical cancer screening

Linked back for continued monitoring and follow-up

Accompanied referrals through community networks
